



IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING PETE & C 2011 PRECONFERENCE WORKSHOPS

The philosophy of PETE & C is that hands-on workshops provide the best learning experience for preconference participants. For this reason, most of the hands-on preconference workshops will be held in computer labs in school districts located within a short drive of the Hershey Conference Center. Seminars that do not include hands-on activities will be held at the Conference Center.

Bus transportation will be provided from the Conference Center to each offsite location and back to the Conference Center at the end of the workshop. Buses will leave the Conference Center at 8:15 a.m. for full-day sessions and 12:15 p.m. for afternoon sessions. At the end of the day, you will be picked up at your location at or close to 4:00 p.m. and taken back to the Conference Center. Should you prefer to drive yourself, a copy of driving directions to all offsite locations is included with these materials.

A continental breakfast will be provided in the morning at the Annville-Cleona High School, as well as at the Conference Center for all participants in preconference activities. For those participants whose sessions are being held at the Hershey High School, please enjoy your breakfast at the Conference Center before you board the bus to the school. Lunch will be provided at no additional cost for all full-day sessions.
